1 Paul and Timothy, bond-servants of Christ Jesus,



3 I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, 4 always offering prayer with joy in my every prayer for you all, 5 in view of your [c]participation in the gospel from the first day until now. 6 For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus. 7 [d] For it is only right for me to feel this way about you all, because I have you in my heart, since both in my [e]imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel, you all are partakers of grace with me. 8 For God is my witness, how I long for you all with the [f] affection of Christ Jesus. 9 And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in real knowledge and all discernment, 10 so that you may [g]approve the things that are excellent, in order to be sincere and blameless [h]until the day of Christ; 11 having been filled with the fruit of righteousness which comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

## **Inductive Bible Study Checklist**

Start off with Prayer!
Ask the 5W's and H (highlight and underline in the text)
Ask questions that you wonder about the text. Try to find the answers yourself first! Then use additional tools as needed.
Mark the key words and phrases (use symbols)
Look for lists (number them)
Look for contrasts/comparisons (note them)
Look for terms of conclusions (ex. therefore, thus, for this reason)
Identify chapter themes (note them)
<ul> <li>Interpret the text</li> <li>□ Pay attention to the context</li> <li>□ Cross-reference scripture</li> <li>□ What form of literature is it?</li> <li>□ Is their figurative language?</li> </ul>
